


## August 2019 Newsletter

The house at 9 Lunt Road has been removed, the storm water drain system is being installed, and the foundation on the Depot Road/adult wing is almost complete. There are also new panelized walls and trusses on the new Lunt Road/Youth Services wing.

### The Wonder of Maine's Wildlife presented by Ed Robinson

Tuesday, August 20 at 6:30 pm at Lunt Auditorium at OceanView

Harpswell, Maine author Ed Robinson has been writing and speaking about the outdoors for years. He created a new presentation that features over 200 superb photographs of many Maine creatures, both the iconic and the secretive. Ed will share fascinating stories about these creatures and help us to understand more about their lives.

Since moving to Maine in 2007 he has written extensively about Maine's wildlife and recently published a book titled *Nature Notes from Maine: River Otters, Moose, Skunks and More*. The book is a collection of 40 stories about species including lobsters, loons, fishers and ospreys. It includes over

60 stunning photographs and 10 ink drawings in 190 pages.

Copies of *Nature Notes from Maine* will be available for sale and signing by the author. All profits from sales of the book will benefit the conservation and public education work of the Harpswell Heritage Land Trust (HHLT) where Ed serves on the board of trustees.
